

NOTICE OF RELEASE: *Draft Rules of Procedure* and *Draft Standard Impact Statement* Guidelines



The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) has released *Draft Rules of Procedure* and *Draft Standard Impact Statement (IS) Guidelines* for consultation pursuant to Section 12.2.23 of the *Nunavut Agreement* and s. 38 of the *NuPPAA*. Both draft documents are available in English, Inuktitut, Inuinnaqtun and French from the NIRB's public registry at www.nirb.ca/rules-of-procedure.

Interested persons, including individuals, corporations, organizations and regulatory authorities are invited to make comments in writing to the Board about the drafts on or before **March 15, 2019**.

The *Draft Rules of Procedure* will apply to NIRB proceedings, including Public Hearings. The *Draft Standard IS Guidelines* provide information to guide Proponents in the preparation of their impact statement documentation as required during the NIRB's assessment of project proposals under Article 12 of the *Nunavut Agreement* and Part 3 of the *NuPPAA*.
